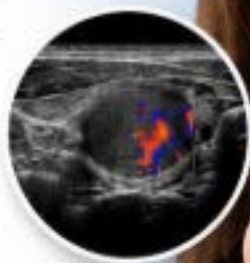

THYROID SCREENING

Early Detection for Better Health

A thyroid ultrasound is a safe, painless, non-invasive screening that evaluates the thyroid gland for nodules, cysts, and other abnormalities.

Because thyroid disease often has no symptoms in the early stages, screening can help detect concerns early—when treatment is most effective.

WHO SHOULD BE SCREENED?

Thyroid screening may be appropriate for:

- Adults with a family history of thyroid disease or thyroid cancer
- Individuals with a thyroid nodule or enlargement
- People with a history of radiation exposure to the head or neck
- Individuals with symptoms of thyroid dysfunction
- Women, who are more likely to develop thyroid conditions



Talk with your healthcare provider to determine if thyroid screening is right for you.



WHAT CAN BE DETECTED?

A thyroid ultrasound can help identify:

- Thyroid nodules (solid or cystic)
- Goiters (enlarged thyroid)
- Inflammation or thyroiditis
- Structural abnormalities
- Changes that may need further evaluation

- ✓ Detect concerns before symptoms develop
- ✓ Guide treatment and monitoring
- ✓ Provide peace of mind
- ✓ Support long-term thyroid health



WHAT HAPPENS AFTER MY SCREENING?

A physician will review your ultrasound and provide a report of your results.

Depending on the findings, your healthcare provider may recommend:

- Additional testing or lab work
- Repeat ultrasound monitoring
- Treatment options
- Referral to an endocrinologist if needed
